

#VOTEBIG Checklist

- Ensure you are registered to vote!**
 - Register early before October 15 to save time on election day
 - Minnesota allows same-day voter registration
- Plan what time you will vote on Election Day.**
 - Polling stations are open from *7am to 8pm
 - *In state and federal elections, towns with less than 500 residents are not required to open until 10am
 - You have a right to time off work to vote without losing pay, taking personal leave, or vacation time
- Know what to bring when you vote.**
 - To register on election day, bring:
 - Valid MN driver's license, learner's permit, or receipt for them
 - Tribal ID with name, address, photo, and signature
 - If your ID does not have current name and address, scan the code on the right to learn how to prepare
- Know who you can bring to the polls with you.**
 - If your photo ID does not have current information, you can bring any of the following people to confirm your address:
 - A registered voter to 'vouch' for you
 - A staff person of your residential facility. Staff personnel must bring proof of employment.
- Locate your nearest polling station:** _____
 - You can do this now, or later by visiting PollFinder.sos.state.MN.US
- Share your plans to vote with a friend or family member, and encourage them to vote!**
- Cast your ballot November 5th, and let your voice be heard! #VoteBig**

Key election dates:

- **September 17**
 - National Voting Registration Day
- **September 20**
 - Start voting by mail or in person
- **October 15**
 - Last day to register early
- **November 5**
 - Election Day (same-day registration available)
